Environmental Policy

(Approved February 25, 2022)

Radius Global Infrastructure, Inc. and its subsidiaries (collectively, the “Company”) sets forth the following Environmental Policy (the “Policy”). This Policy is intended to guide the Company’s strategic and day-to-day decision-making processes for the Company, its Board of Directors, officers and employees and to integrate the consideration of environmental concerns and impacts into their decision making and activities.

1. The Company is committed to environmental stewardship and to mitigating its potential impact on the environment, including, when applicable, environmental risk analyses and disclosing material environmental impacts that its operations may have.
2. The Company is dedicated to ensuring it remains in compliance with applicable local, state, and national environmental laws in the jurisdictions in which it operates and to regularly review its practices to ensure its actions are compatible with the objectives stated in this Policy.
3. The Company is committed, consistent with applicable corporate fiduciary responsibilities, that it will:
 - Incorporate environmental, social, and corporate governance ("ESG") issues into strategic analysis and decision-making processes;
 - Strive to incorporate ESG issues into its policies and practices where consistent with the manner in which the Company undertakes triple net leases with our business partners, customers and tenants;
 - Request appropriate and applicable information and disclosure on ESG issues by third party entities with which the Company works or engages; and
 - Report, when appropriate and applicable, on its activities and progress.
4. The Company acknowledges the United Nation’s resolution regarding the human right to water and sanitation, and specifically, that everyone is entitled to sufficient, safe, acceptable, physically accessible and affordable water for personal and domestic uses. To the extent that the Company’s operations in the future result in a known material violation of local, state, federal or international environmental laws, regulations or policies, the Company commits to disclosing those findings publicly.
5. The Company is committed to better understanding its energy usage and carbon footprint in an effort to identify further opportunities to reduce such impacts.
6. The Company is not a hazardous waste generator. With respect to general waste reduction, the Company has implemented a recycling program at its offices. The Company’s offices are equipped with general waste receptacles as well as a variety of recycle receptacles for paper, plastics, glass, and aluminum and employees are encouraged to make smart choices when it comes to waste.
